

BOTTOM LINE: If you want to know God, start with Jesus.

Read John 14:6

What do you KNOW?

Grab a piece of paper and some markers. At the top of the paper rainbow write JESUS. Underneath it, write all the things that you know about Jesus.

Ask an adult to help you look up the verse of the week in **John 14:6.** What a powerful verse to know. This verse means that Jesus truly can change your life! You can add what you learned in this verse to your JESUS list!

Thank God for sending Jesus so we can know Him more.

Grab a piece of paper and some colored pencils or crayons. Now, take your piece of paper and fold it in half and then fold in half one more time to make a book. On the outside, draw a picture of yourself. If someone were to write a book about you what would you want everyone to know? Write or draw these things inside your book.

Just like we can tell people about us, Jesus did the same! Did you know that four different people who spent time with Jesus wrote separate books in the Bible about His life on earth? So, it must be important for us to learn about Jesus and His life!

Ask God to help you learn more about Jesus every day.

Picture It

This week we have been learning that to know more about God we start by learning more about Jesus. Is there something new that you have learned about Jesus this week? If so, grab a piece of paper and some crayons and write or draw a picture of it. If you haven't learned something new, where can you go? That's right, the Bible. Ask an adult to read a story about the life of Jesus with you (Look for a story from Matthew, Mark, Luke or John). As they are reading, draw a picture of what you are hearing about Jesus.
