Greetings!

Christmas is here and everyone says I can't believe it's already here but it is. A time when we pause and stop to celebrate and remember the greatest miracle of God sending His only Son to be a helpless baby to come and live among us - to be Emmanuel - God with us! A miracle that should cause us to step back in awe and wonder at a God who would love us in such a personal way and a way that He could relate to every one of us! How great the Father's love for us! So in the midst of lots of fun times, parties, time with family, eating, and more may we stop often and remember the wonder of Christmas and what that means for you and me.

May we also stop and remember too that for many, Christmas, the most wonderful time of the year, is also a time that can be very difficult for them due to an illness, first Christmas without a loved one, financial struggle, or even facing someone who is struggling to live. May we be sensitive and find ways to minister to others during this Christmas season.

Let me encourage you to begin to pray now about three important things.

- (1) Pray about your gift to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering for International Missions. We do this every year, but I'm praying that all of us will indeed give a sacrificial gift this year to help us reach and go well over our goal of \$25,000 + to help reach the nations. I encourage you to give more than just \$20, but to really stop and consider what that gift should be, one that is sacrificial. Get your family involved in the giving too!
- (2) Pray about your end of the year giving for 2017 and even looking into 2018 as we present our 2018 Church Ministry Plan. There are so many things we feel called to do and just don't have the resources to do them. Many of you give faithfully and sacrificially and I thank you, but many still do not. Please consider giving an end of the year gift to help us catch up to our budget so we can move into 2018 with a strong foundation. Also, be praying about taking that next step up the generosity ladder in 2018 so you can become a regular giver and tither and beyond!
- (3) Invite a family member, friend, neighbor, co-worker, or classmate who does not go to church to our Annual Candlelight Christmas Family Worship Service which this year is on Christmas Eve. Be sure to invite them to join you at 10:30 a.m. as we come together to celebrate the birth of Christ.

We have some incredibly exciting things planned and in store for 2018. Just want to briefly mention 2 of them. First we are going to challenge our entire church to read through the Bible in 2018 together with a brand new message series that will take us through every book of the Bible plus LifeGroups that will do the same. It's going to be incredible. Second, in the late spring we are planning on launching Outlive Your Life: The next Chapter which is a 1 year campaign designed to help us finish and complete all of the 1st floor of our building plus additional paved parking lot and a few other things to help us continue to fulfill our mission of engaging people with the hope of the gospel to see lives transformed.

I pray that you and your family have a wonderful Christmas season and I look forward to seeing each of you this Sunday!

Well over 100 years ago, a single missionary named Lottie Moon, while serving in China, began writing letters challenging the American church to send and support more workers to go there. After her death on the field, her challenge was heeded in the formalization of an offering in her name. Even if you're not a Southern Baptist who has given to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering, her life is a reminder of why we must give to send and support missionaries serving among unreached peoples in unreached places. Starting in 1888, the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering® was established to empower the international missions efforts for Southern Baptists. After more than a century, the annual offering continues its steady growth. The National Goal this year is \$160 Million. **Our church goal is \$25,000!** Your giving enables missionaries to be sent to make disciples and multiply churches among unreached peoples and places for the glory of God. We will have an in-gathering Sunday, December 17th.

Church Ministry Plan Meeting Presentation & Discussion December 13




Voting on December 17th






A companion devotional with the reading plan along with extra resources to help you get the most out of reading through the Bible in 2018. Cost: \$10
