


King David

2 SAMUEL 7-8

King David's palace was finished. King David said, "I live in a great house. God's ark of the covenant still sits in a tent."

David wanted to build a house for God, but God sent David a different message.

God sent the prophet Nathan to King David. "God says He does not need a house to live in. Since the time He brought the people from Egypt, He has traveled around with the tabernacle tent."



Nathan reminded David that God was with Him when he was a shepherd boy, that God was always with David, and that God defeated David's enemies. God promised that David's son would build a house for worshiping God. He promised to help David's son and to love him.

God said, "Tell David that someone from his family will always be on the throne."

When David heard the words, he worshiped God right away. David thought about all God had done for him. He thought about all God promised to do for him and his family. David was thankful for God's promises to him.

Then David and his army defeated every enemy. He took their gold and silver to give to God. Then David ruled with justice over the whole country.

LIFE POINT: God will help people through hard times.


THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE


