

## Daniel Interpreted the King's Dreams

#### **DANIEL 2**

Daniel worked hard and was very smart. God helped Daniel to do something special. He was able to

understand visions and dreams. This was a special gift from God.

King Nebuchadnezzar was having dreams that worried him. These dreams were keeping him awake at night.
