Assumption

"When you pray"

Audience – Man Key Word: Hypocrite

- ✓ **The Place**: Public
- ✓ **The Purpose:** Announce Ourselves
- ✓ **The Prize:** Men's Applause & Approval

Note: Nothing wrong with praying in public

Audience – the Lord Key Word: Authentic

- ✓ **The Place** Private
 - Secret
 - Secluded
 - Silent
 - Sincerity
- ✓ **The Purpose** Align Ourselves with Our Father
- ✓ **The Prize** God's Applause, Approval & Answers

Approach

✓ Duplication

Nothing wrong with repeating genuine requests

✓ Duration

Nothing wrong praying for extended periods of time

Desperation & Dependence \checkmark

Our Response:

- 1. 1. Would you be certain today that the Lord hears your prayers? The only way He hears you is if He is your Savior and Lord. Is He? If not, He will hear your cry today to make Him your Savior and Lord. Remember, it is as easy as ABC. Admit to God you are a sinner, Ask for His forgiveness, Believe Jesus is God's Son, Confess Him as Savior and Commit Your Life to Him as Lord.
- 2. Do a private heart check-up today. Are you praying on a regular basis? Do you spend time alone with the Lord each day in prayer? Do you then pray throughout your day? If not, then make plans this week to spend time in prayer each day.
- 3. Do a **public heart check-up**. When you do pray in public, what is your motive? Remember who are praying to an audience of one. Are you coming to prayer meeting to pray together with other believers? If not, maybe try coming this week.
- 4. Are you praying for your church, its leadership and that God will continue to pour out His blessings here in amazing ways? If not, then add that to your daily prayer list.
- 5. Be reminded this week that the Heavenly Father already knows what you need, even before we ask. Go ahead and ask, He loves to hear His children crying out to Him. Remember, nothing wrong with praying about things on your heart over and over again.
- 6. Get in a LifeGroup & develop **your** Battle Plan for Prayer!
