Godly Leaders Are Able to Guide & Direct All People in All Kinds of Situations 1 Timothy 2:9-15; 5:1-16; 6:1-2; Titus 2:1-10 Read Titus 2:1-10

Godly Leaders Have The Right Motivation 1 Timothy 5:5-21

- ✓ The Design – godliness leads to contentment
- ✓ The Danger – love of money is root of all kinds of evil
- ✓ The Determination – Flee these things & pursue the right things
- ✓ The Direction to Give – fix your hope on Christ and not money
