Who is His Love poured out on? ...**The World... The greatest number!!**

WHAT IS THE WORLD?

- What God created - planet earth & Who God created - you and me
- The world is opposed to God – His Kingdom, His Order, His Rule and His Reign
- Satan is the prince of this world rules the world, but under the King’s authority. (John 12, 14, & 16)

WHO IS THE WORLD?

- Over 7 Billion People on the Planet
- 11,249 People Groups
- 6,525 Unreached People Groups – this makes up more than half of the world’s population!
- 3800 of these Unreached are Unengaged - meaning that they have less than 2% of the population are believers and have no known church planting movement or strategy in the last two years.

If the world had only 100 People...

Where We Live:

11 would be Europeans

14 would live in North or South America

13 would be Africans & 62 would be Asians

Who We Are:

51 would be female & 49 would be male

70 would be people of color & 30 would be white

What We Have:

7 people would possess 50% of the world’s wealth & all 7 would be U.S. Citizens

80 would live in substandard housing
67 would not be able to read
60 suffer from malnutrition
1 is near death & 1 is near birth
1 is a college graduate & 1 owns a computer

What We Believe:

10 would be deeply committed followers of Jesus Christ.
20 might call themselves Christians, but their commitment is doubtful
40 would have some access to the gospel, but they would have not yet responded
30 would have little or no access to gospel
That means 70% of the world's population almost 4 billion have little or no access to the gospel!!

WHAT DID GOD DO FOR THE WORLD?

- God sent Jesus to die for us, but not only us, but the whole world.
I John 2:2 “It was the world God so loved. It was not a nation; it was not good people; it was not only the people who loved Him; it was the world. The unlovable, the lonely who have no one else to love them, the man who loves God and the man who never thinks of Him, the man who rests in the love of God and the man who spurns it – all are included in this vast inclusive love of God. As Augustine had it: God loves each one of us as if there was only one of us to love.” William Barclay Yet He loves the whole world!
- He did not come to condemn the world, but that through Him the world might be saved. (John 3:17 & 2 Corinthians 5:19)

WHAT IS GOD'S DESIRE FOR THE WORLD?

- He wants the whole world to know (The Great Commission) Matthew (28:19-20, & Acts 1:8)
- His desire is that none would perish, but have everlasting life. (II Peter 3:9 Matthew 24:14)
- His plan is to gather together every tribe, language, nation, and people group to one day worship before His throne. (Revelation 7:9-10 Psalm 46:10, Psalm 86:8-9, Psalm 22:27)

1 John 2:2

2 He himself is the sacrifice that atones for our sins—and not only our sins but the sins of all the world. NLT

2 Cor 5:17-21

17 This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! 18 And all of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him. 19 For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. 20 So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!" 21 For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ. NLT
