"The Incredible Value of Life" *Jeremiah 1:1-10*January 19, 2014 AM Service

Brief Introduction of the Series – try and pick up last Sunday's message and include it in next Sunday's Message – This series is designed to look at what God Values the most and though He values everything for sure, we wanted to see what would be the top 3-4 things. Hence iValue – I AM Values, and if God values something then so should we! It should change some things about who we are and how we live our lives! The First and foremost thing that God values is His Glory more than anything else and we'll talk about that though briefly next week. Today, we want to talk about the fact that the Lord values life since He is the Creator, Giver, Sustainer, and ultimately deciding when our life on earth is through – God values life! The 3rd and 4th go together in that God values the Gospel as well as the Church. He died so that we could know Him and have a relationship with Him and the Church is the vehicle through which the Gospel is spread through the world – and that will dovetail beautifully into our Church-wide series in February entitled – I Am a Church Member. So the theme here is then we know what God values, then no doubt we should value highly the things that God values – in fact we should value them over anything else in our lives!

The Politics and Principles of the Day Vs 1-3

In absolute turmoil... describe – sacrificing their children to false gods. He was no more than twenty years old His name means God exalts, - God glorifies – through the life of Jeremiah God was glorified.

God's Pattern & Our Purpose Vs 4-5

- ✓ **He Formed Us** (Created Us) Psalms 139:13-16 Let us be clear about our stance as a Christ Follower about Life -
- ✓ He Knows Us Before we were even formed, conceived, and he knows everything about us even right now to the number of hairs on your head!! And thinks about us during the day more than all the sands on the seashores put together! That's knowing someone!

- ✓ **He Set Us Apart** consecrated you- You are set apart this morning from the time you were born until right now... He has set you apart for you to be His child and set apart for a purpose... Set apart to in this world but not of this world.
- ✓ **He Chose Us** He has a purpose for you for Jeremiah it was a prophet and not a priest like his father, the Lord has chosen you and me to be His servants, His spokesperson if you will just like Jeremiah was and to share the word of the Lord with others in particular on this day, we are called to speak for life, to speak for the unborn who can't yet speak. Each of our calling is different and how we live that calling out is different, yet we are all called.
